## Abstract

This descriptive research determined to evaluate the performance of student aides in John B. Lacson Colleges Foundation (Molo), Inc. first semester school year 2005-2006. The participants were the 54 student aides employing the simple random sampling method using Slovin's formula in determining the sample size. A Student Aides Performance Evaluation second semester school year 2004-2005 from the office of the Student Personnel Services was employed. Descriptive statistics used were means and standard deviations. Inferential statistics employed were t-test for independent samples and One-Way Analysis of Variance (ANOVA) set at .05 alpha level. Results revealed that, the

performance evaluation of student aides was "very satisfactory". No significant differences existed in the performance of student aides when classified according to year level, course, and gender.
