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#### **ABSTRACT**

This descriptive study was conducted in July 2018 to determine the factors affecting SHS students of JBLFMU- Molo in choosing Tourism management as a course. This study employed a survey research among 72 randomly selected SHS students in ABM strand of grade 11 and grade 12. Frequency, percentage, rank, mode, mean, standard deviation, ANOVA and Likert scale were used in processing the data. The analysis of data revealed the following. (1) This study revealed that there were significant differences on choosing a preferred course. Significant differences were identified in different variable which was statistically significant. (2) It only showed that these factors can affect an individual or the respondents on choosing his/her preferred course in college. (3) Respondents' decision-making in choosing Tourism management as a course was affected when grouped according to age, sex, religion, family status, number of siblings and family income.
