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Abstract

This descriptive-correlational research focused on the impact of on-the-job training (OJT) among the second year CSM students of JBLFMU-Molo, Inc. Sources of data were 100 BSCSM Students of the Business Department of the John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University- Molo, Inc. during the second semester of 2009-2010. Sampling method used was the proportionate random sampling. Means and standard deviations were the descriptive statistics used. Inferential statistics used was Spearman rho set at .05 alpha level. The on-the-job training has high impact on students' development whether for personal or educational reason. If students' personal factors were taken into account, the impact of OJT development is still high.
