Abstract

This study aimed to determine the level of preparedness of the college of Business Students of JBLFMU-Molo towards the 2010 election. The participants of this research were 144 randomly selected college of Business students enrolled this 1st semester of 2009. The data needed for the study were obtained from the questionnaires distributed to the participants. Descriptive statistics used where means and standard deviations. One - way analysis of variance and t-test were the inferential statistics used. Results revealed that generally, the college of Business students' level of preparedness towards 2010 election was found to be "Highly Prepared" when classified to (a) place of residence (b) courses and (c) sex. There are no significant differences in the level of preparedness of college of business students of JBLFMU towards the upcoming 2010 election when classified according to (a) place of residence (b) courses and (c) sex.
