Abstract

The purpose of this study was to ascertain the level of satisfaction in the modular subjects at John B. Lacson Colleges Foundation-Molo, Inc. This research utilized a questionnaire developed by the researchers. The participants of this study were the 100 randomly selected students of second and third year students of Marine Engineering Department of JBLCF-Molo. Frequency count, percentage and mean were employed for descriptive analysis. Results showed that the level of satisfaction in the modular subjects as perceived by the Marine Engineering students "high satisfied" as an entire group and when grouped according to classification, type of residence, and year level.
