Abstract

This research aimed to determine the locus of control among BSBA students. This was conducted during the first semester, academic year 2010-2011. Forty-six randomly selected BSBA students were administered a ten-item questionnaire on locus of control. The participants were classified according to gender, year level and student classification. The data gathered were analyzed and interpreted using the descriptive statistics such as mean and standard deviation. The *t*-test and One-Way ANOVA were used as inferential data tools. The study found that the locus of control of BSBA students when taken as a whole and even when grouped according to gender, year level, and student classification was "moderate internal". The study also revealed that there is no significant difference in the locus of control among the BSBA students when classified according to gender, year level, and student classification.
