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*Abstract*

The study was conducted to determine the perceived effects of ICT among BSCSM students at John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University- Molo, when classified according to age, sex and year level. The participants of the study were the 328 randomly selected Bachelor of Science in Cruise Ship Management from 1<sup>st</sup> year to 4<sup>th</sup> year students. The researchers used the descriptive type of research and made a questionnaire which measured the perceived effects of ICT among CSM students. Completion of the questionnaire was used to gather data needed for the research. Descriptive statistics used were frequency count and percentage. The present investigation revealed the following results when BSCSM students used ICT are the following: Using computer- based materials spends them less time in doing their assignments and reports; browsing social networking sites provides a venue to discuss classroom lessons with their classmates and teachers; it is easy for them to understand lessons by presenting it through ICT materials; using ICT- based materials helps them become more participative in class discussion; and lastly, using the internet makes their assignments easier than using a book.
