Abstract

This study determined the perceived occurrence of sexual harassment on women seafarers onboard among the seafarers/trainees at JBLF, Inc. Training Center. The participants are the randomly selected trainees enrolled in different short courses. The study employed the descriptive research method and the researcher made instrument on the "perceived occurrence of sexual harassment on women seafarers onboard". Descriptive statistics used were means and standards deviation and t-test for independent sample and One-Way ANOVA set at .05 level of significance. Results revealed that the participants perceived the occurrence of sexual harassment among women seafarer's onboard to be "fairly occurred". There is no significant difference existed in the level of perception on the occurrence of sexual harassment
