ABSTRACT

Young students have diverse dreams and interests in life. In choosing a career, suitability to the interest of the students is given importance. Students must know on what degree to pursue in college, one that interest them and must also fit their abilities so that it will not be hard for them to choose the right career path. This study would like to determine "Preference on taking Tourism and Cruise Ship Management Among ABM Students of John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University – Molo, Inc." Specifically, this study sought to answer the following questions. What is the profile of the respondents in terms of year level, section, gender and age. What is the level of preference on taking tourism and cruise ship management among ABM students classified according to year level, section, gender and age?
