*Abstract*

The purpose of conducting this study was to determine the preparedness towards the LECB. The respondents were the 40 randomly selected fourth year BSCA students of John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University - Molo, Inc. who were classified according to sex and GPA. The data were gathered using a questionnaire modified by the researchers. Statistical tools used for the study were the mean and standard deviation for the descriptive data analysis and Pearson's  $r$  for inferential data analysis. Results of the study showed that whether taken as an entire group and when grouped according to sex, both male and female BSCA students have the same "good" GPA. When taken as an entire group, BSCA students were "fairly prepared" towards the Licensure Examination for Customs Brokers.
