Abstract

This study determined the reasons why John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University - Molo Marine Engineering students are not attending school activities. The respondents of the study were the ninety (90) randomly selected Bachelor of Science in Marine Engineering students of John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University-Molo. A validated researchers-made questionnaire was used to gather the data needed for this study. The data gathered were subjected to descriptive statistics such as frequency, percentage and rank. The study revealed that the topmost reason and common reason why Bachelor of Science in Marine Engineering students do not attend school activities is that they feel bored watching the programs. This is the primary reason whether the respondents are taken as an entire group or grouped according to year level and residence. Other dominant reasons are "I choose to work for other requirements" and "I like having rest day." These are two other primary reasons whether the respondents are classified as entire group or grouped according to year level and residence.
