ABSTRACT

This research is a descriptive survey conducted in June 2018. It primarily determined the satisfaction level of the 4P's beneficiaries on the government subsidy for medical assistance considering the variables as age, sex and residence. The respondents were 30 4P's beneficiary patients from the Don Benito Hospital selected by homogeneous purposive sampling. Data were obtained through a survey questionnaire, measuring the satisfaction level of the 4P's beneficiaries on Government subsidy on medical assistance. SPSS was used to analyse the data. It was found out that only the variable age has a significant difference, specifically, in statement 5. In the statement "Employees of the hospital assisted all 4P's medical needs." has the high significance in terms of age, respondents aging 40 and above has different answers with respondents aging 40 and below. Also the data reveals that the 4P's beneficiaries are highly satisfied with the government subsidy for medical assistance.
